Programme Aim: To provide learners with the opportunity to develop the knowledge, skills, and competencies necessary to select the correct tools and equipment required to build a range of brick and block walls. The learners will explore maintenance on equipment, ensuring it is maintained correctly. Participants will develop skills in following drawings to set out work required, using the technique & methods set out to cut the brick or block allowing them to join correctly and mix the desired batch of motor to the required specified proportion. Learners will be able to construct a range of brick and block walls to comply with supplied drawings while adhering to health and safety requirements at all times

Participants of this programme will:

- · Understand what health and safety legislation effects brick and block laying
- Identify the correct PPE needed in order to complete a range of brick and block laying tasks
- · Be able to plan and design an area using drawings and sketches
- Complete a range of tasks to an excellent standard
- Be confident when mixing motor for a required area
- · Cut bricks or blocks to joint them correctly
- Understand the equipment required for brick or block laying and the maintenance on equipment required

Required fluency in generic skills	Generally learners engaging in learning activities leading to level 3 awards are ready to take on a new task in a personal capacity or role. Learners can follow direction and are moving towards independent learning. Learners will have the ability to read basic short text in a non-supported environment and will be able to make sense of quantitative information within a familiar setting or unfamiliar task in a familiar setting
QQI Assessment	Participants who wish to achieve a QQI component certificate must complete 100% Skills Demonstration
Resources Required in Order to Successfully Complete the Module	Some personal learning / study time will be required from participants. Programme packs, Assessment Briefs and some equipment will be provided as part of the programme
Specific Entry/Access & Exemptions required	Access to programmes leading to level 3 is open. A learner seeking entry to a programme leading to awards at level 3 does not need a previous formal qualification. Some learners may have achieved certification at level 2. Recognition of Prior Learning may be considered to gain access without having certification entry requirements, to gain exception within a programme, attain an award based on experience which they don't hold formal qualification in, contact our office for more information
