First Aid Response Programme (FAR- PHECC)

Programme aim: The aim of this programme is to enable the participants to respond to emergencies in a pre-hospital environment. The participant will explore assessment and management of different illnesses and injuries until the emergency medical team arrive. First Aid Responders must be able to demonstrate a commitment to the process of continuous responder competence.

Learning outcomes:

Learners will be able to Recognise and Assess the causes and effects of sudden illness and injury in a prehospital environment and be able to react to such pre-hospital emergencies. Learners will understand how to respond in a safe, effective, and appropriate manner to such emergencies utilising the First Aid Response skill set. Learners will know how to record and report incidents appropriately when handing over to medical teams.
