Programme Aim: This programme has been designed to help enable participants to develop the knowledge and skills necessary to prepare, plan, and complete a range of tiling activities correctly understanding different methods, reasons, and designs used in the industry. Participants will learn to correctly measure an area, design tiling patterns, complete cutting, fixing, laying, and finishing techniques used by professionals while using the correct tools and techniques. This programme will ensure that participants understand all safety measures involved in this activity to maintain adherence to current legislation.

Participants of this programme will:

- Understand tools and materials used in tiling activities
- Measure areas correctly to estimate cost of a project
- Design and identify a number of tiling patterns
- Prepare an area for tiling
- · Be capable of cutting, fixing, and laying tiles correctly
- Understand how to complete grouting on laid tiles
- Know how to correctly clean an area after tiling has been completed
- Understand safety requirements associated with tiling activities and possible threats that could cause harm

Programme Content

- Select materials and tools required to complete a range of tiling activities
- Understand relevant tools and techniques used by professionals to tile an area
- Prepare an area for tiling, complete cutting, fix, and lay tiles
- Grouting and cleaning an area after project completed
- Follow designs and patterns while laying tiles
- Understand relevant health and safety legislation

Specific Entry/Access & Exemptions required	Access to programmes leading to level 3 is open. A learner seeking entry to a programme leading to awards at level 3 does not need a previous formal qualification. Some learners may have achieved certification at level 2. Recognition of Prior Learning may be considered to gain access without having certification entry requirements, to gain exception within a programme, attain an award based on experience which they don't hold formal qualification in, contact our office for more information

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
