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# **Mechanical Pesticide Application 5N20435**

**Programme Aim:** The aim of this programme is to equip learners with the knowledge, skills, and competency to achieve a QQI Level 5 award in Mechanical Pesticide Application 5N20435. On completion learners will be capable of identifying legislative requirements in relation to the use of pesticide, demonstrating understanding of the principles of application by using a range of pesticide applicators including a boom sprayer, and slug pellet applicator safely, using required PPE, setting up and calibrating correctly and completing all relevant required paperwork.

# Participants of this programme will:

- Describe the range of mechanically propelled equipment for the application of plant protection products
- Principles of application technology necessary for the proper application of pesticides
- Working principles of a boom sprayer, machine mounted slug pellet applicator and trailed weed lick
- Legislative requirements pertaining to pesticide applicators
- Apply a pesticide mix with a boom sprayer
- set up, calibrate, and operate a mechanically propelled weed-licker
- set up, calibrate and operate a mechanically propelled full width broadcast or placement pesticide pellet applicator

- Trailed weed lick

QQI Assessment	Participants who wish to achieve a QQI Component Certificate must complete 80% Skills Demonstration 40% Exam
Resources Required in Order to Successfully Complete the Module	Some personal learning / study time will be required from participants. Programme packs, assessment briefs and some equipment will be provided as part of the programme
Specific Entry/Access & Exemptions required	A learner seeking entry to a programme leading to awards at level 5 does not need a previous formal qualification. HCT would highly recommend that learners have achieved some certification at Level 4 or have relevant work/life experience. Recognition of Prior Learning may be considered to gain access without having certification entry requirements, to gain exception within a programme, attain an award based on experience which they don't hold formal qualification in, contact our office for more information
